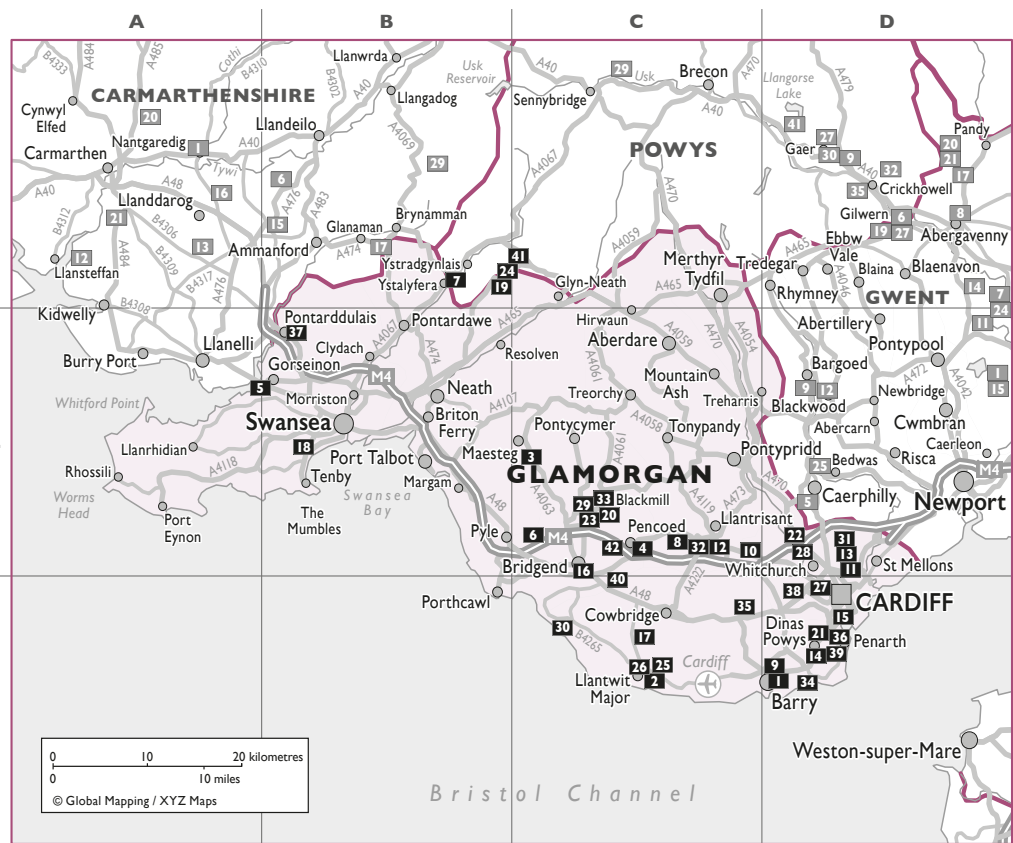

NEW 333 BARRY ROAD D3

Barry, South Glamorgan, CF62 8HG. Mrs Jo Tanner. Central Barry, 4m from Cardiff. Garden on Barry Rd, close to The Cherry Orchard public house. Follow NGS signs. What3words app: snap.cute.closer. **Sat 11 Apr (12-5); Sun 12 Apr (12-4); Sat 27 June (12-5); Sun 28 June (11-3). Adm £5, chd free. Tea, coffee & cake.**

A newly designed and planted cottage garden (2024-25). Follow a winding path that leads you past borders filled with spring bulbs, perennials, roses, shrubs and some small trees. A pond and bug hotels together with bee-friendly plants encourage wildlife to the garden. Flat with a variety of spaces to sit and enjoy the space. Beyond the arbour is a greenhouse and raised beds.

Discover a range of mature and espalier fruit trees, a wildlife pond and secluded bird hide. There is a raised kerb to enter from the road which may require assistance. Thereafter level grass throughout.

Many interesting mature trees, young fruit trees, rhododendrons, ponds, numerous roses and standards, and much else of interest, even in the wilder areas. Lawn used for tennis in last century, now smaller and left unmown in parts, wildflowers encouraged. We live and let live, encourage all wildlife, try to garden organically.

sitting areas to enjoy the sun at all hours of the day. There are roses: tea, rambling, climbing and clematis, hydrangeas, dierama, honeysuckles, buddleia, cosmos, to carry you through the seasons.

A beautifully landscaped terraced garden creating a classical and elegant atmosphere. The garden is divided into two sections; the upper section, connected to the Grade II listed house, the oldest part of the garden. The second section is at a lower level; with several ornate statues, stone urns and planters, here, the garden was created from scratch. Stunning views over the River Loughor. An ancient chapel, a pond, and a hedge maze surround a Grade II listed house that was home to the Knights Templar and the Knights Hospitaller, two significant military orders from the Crusades, giving the current house its name. The garden can be accessed by wheelchair through the rear gate of the property.

Cefn Cribwr is an old mining village atop a ridge with views of Swansea to the west, Somerset to the south and home to Bedford Park and the Cefn Cribwr Iron Works. The village hall is at the centre with teas, cakes and plants for sale. The allotments are to be found behind the hall. Children, art and relaxation are just some of the themes to be found in the gardens besides the flower beds and vegetables. There are also water features, fish ponds, wildlife ponds, summerhouses and hens adding to the diverse mix in the village. Themed colour borders, roses, greenhouses, recycling, composting and much more. The Coal Tip Garden is a small personal space created to help us relax. Its main character is enclosure. It is not a flowery garden but is formed out of shrubs and trees- a tapestry with niches being cut in order to place sculpture and to produce a visual rhythm. A key philosophy is using native perennials and repetitive planting leading the eye through the space to the studio.

Each quite different, they combine some of the best characteristics of design and planting for modern town gardens as well as cottage gardens. Each has its own forte: Waunwyllt's 1/2 acre is divided into garden rooms and 28 Maes y Nant is where cottage garden planting reigns. Regret, cash only at gardens.



107 NEW CYNCOED ROAD D2

Cardiff, South Glamorgan, CF23 6AD. Barney & Kamila Hawthorne. Opp the entrance to Cardiff Met University on Cyncoed Rd. Come off the A48 at the Llanedeyrn turnoff, 1st exit off the r'about onto Llanedeyrn Rd. R at the top onto Cyncoed Rd. Garden is on the L, 3 houses after Cefn Coed Rd. **Sat 4 July (11-5). Adm £5, chd free. Tea, coffee & cake.** A spacious garden, with spring interest at the front camellias, azaleas and hellebores. The back garden is approached through a Japanese walkway, leading to a series of landscaped borders, inc herbaceous perennials, acers, a roped rose colonnade, and pond planting. A round bed containing a showstopper weeping pear with a heuchera clock. Overlooked by a sun terrace showcasing begonias.

This garden is a labour of love. Through the years it has steadily evolved into a peaceful haven with seating and shaded areas. A stream runs through the garden past the summerhouse. The shaded areas of the garden have a variety of ferns and hostas, the remainder of the garden has an array of acers, herbaceous border, and the garden is crowned by a large oak tree.

A medium sized, much loved garden. Owners share a passion for plants and structure, each year the lawn gets smaller to allow for the acquisition of new features.
